1. I F R E D E R I C K A R N O L D G O O D L I F F E
the Elder of Leicester Gentleman revoke all former testa-
mentary dispositions and declare this to be my last Will.

2. I A P P O I N T my friends Henry Swain Bennett
Corn Merchant and John Henry Baker Accountant both of
Leicester Executors and Trustees hereof and I BEQUEATH
to each of them a Legacy of fifty pounds free of Duty
for their trouble in executing the trusts of this my
Will.

3. I B E Q U E A T H to my son Frederick Arnold
Goodliffe such of my household furniture and effects and
of my Plate Books Pictures and Prints as he shall select
to a value not exceeding ^{Three} ~~one~~ hundred and fifty pounds and
I also B E Q U E A T H to him my jewellery and other
personal effects.

4. I B E Q U E A T H to my wife absolutely all my wines

liquors fuel and other consumable household stores and provisions linen china and glass and the residue of my household furniture plate Books Pictures and Prints not hereinbefore bequeathed and an immediate legacy of One hundred pounds. _____

5. I D E V I S E to my Trustees A L L that messuage ✓
now used as a shop Number 95 Saint Saviours Road Leicester
A N D also A L L that messuage with the garden stables
and outbuildings situate in the London Road Leicester
now in my own occupation unto my Trustees U P O N
T R U S T that they shall at such time or times in such
manner and subject to such conditions as they shall in
their absolute discretion think fit sell the same and
stand possessed of the proceeds thereof upon the trusts
hereinafter declared concerning the same for the benefit
of my son Frederick Arnold Goodliffe his wife and children ✓

6. I D E V I S E all the residue of my real estate and bequeath all my personal estate not hereinbefore otherwise disposed of unto the Trustees hereinbefore named

U P O N T R U S T that my Trustees shall at such time or times in such manner and subject to such conditions as they shall in their absolute discretion think fit sell my real estate and convert into money such part of my personal estate as shall not consist of money with full power to postpone su-ch sale and conversion for such period as they may think fit with full power to retain any investments subsisting at my death whether real or personal and including shares not fully paid up.

7. M Y T R U S T E E S out of the money to arise from such sale and conversion as aforesaid and with my ready money shall pay my funeral and testamentary expenses debts and legacies and shall stand possessed of the

residue of such moneys and of my unsold residuary realty and unconverted personalty (hereinafter referred to as "the trust premises") U P O N T R U S T out of the income thereof in the first place to pay to my Wife an annuity of One hundred and fifty pounds during her life by equal quarterly payments without power of anticipation the first of such payments to be made at the expiration of three calendar months from my decease B U T I D I R E C T that in the event of my wife marrying again the said annuity of One hundred and fifty pounds shall be reduced to an annuity of Fifty pounds such reduced annuity to be payable quarterly without power of anticipation and the first reduced payment to be made on the quarterly day of payment which shall happen next after the marriage of my widow and I E M P O W E R my Trustees if they think fit out of the trust premises

to appropriate a sum sufficient at the period of
appropriation as a fund for answering the said annuity
to my wife by investing the same in any of the securities
as hereinafter authorised for the investment of trust funds
and from time to time to change such investments for
others of the authorised kind A N D I D E C L A R E
that from and after such appropriation the residue of the
trust premises shall be liberated from the trust for
payment of the said annuity but the appropriated fund
shall (without prejudice to the said annuity) be subject
to the trusts hereinafter declared concerning the residue
of the trust premises A N D I D I R E C T my Trustees
to stand possessed of the said residue of the trust
premises I N T R U S T for such of my children living
at my decease and such of the issue then living of any ch-
ild or children of mine dying in my lifetime as either befo-
re or after my decease shall attain the age of Twenty one

years such children and issue to take as tenants in common in equal shares per stirpes and not per capita

P R O V I D E D A L W A Y S and I H E R E B Y

D I R E C T my Trustees to hold the share of the trust premises to which my son Frederick Arnold Goodliffe shall be entitled under the provisions of this clause

U P O N T R U S T to pay to him thereout the sum of

one thousand ——— pounds and retain the residue

thereof upon the trusts declared in the next following

clause for the benefit of my said son Frederick Arnold

Goodliffe his wife and children. _____

8. I DIRECT my Trustees to stand possessed of the portion or share of my said son Frederick Arnold Goodliffe of the trust premises directed to be retained under the last preceding Clause hereof and of the proceeds of sale of the real estate hereinbefore devised UPON TRUSTS for the benefit of my said son UPON TRUST to invest the same and to pay the income thereof to my said son during his

lifetime subject to the proviso hereinafter contained
PROVIDED ALWAYS and I HEREBY DECLARE that if my said son
shall at the time of my death have alienated charged or
incumbered or attempted to alienate charge or incumber
or if he shall at any time or times thereafter alienate
charge or incumber or attempt to alienate charge or
incumber the said income or any part thereof or interest
therein or if by reason of his Bankruptcy or other event
happening either before or after such death the said income
shall wholly or in part fail or cease to be personally
enjoyed by my said son or the same or any part thereof
shall or but for this present proviso would belong to or
become vested in some other person or persons then the
trust in favour of my said son hereinbefore expressed
concerning the said income shall immediately thereupon
cease and determine and the same income shall be held by my

Trustees during all the then residue of the life of my said son in the manner following (that is to say) UPON TRUST during the residue of the life of my said son or during such shorter period continuous or discontinuous as my Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit to pay and apply the said income or any part thereof to and for the personal support and maintenance or otherwise for the benefit of my said son his wife child or children or remoter issue for the time being (if any) whether infants or of full age of my said son or such one or more exclusively of the others or other of such persons and in such manner as my Trustees in their absolute discretion shall think fit And subject to the discretionary trust lastly hereinbefore contained UPON TRUST for the period of twenty one years after my death to accumulate in the way of compound interest and invest the income of the

trust fund or so much thereof as shall from time to time not be paid or applied as aforesaid in augmentation of the principal or capital of the trust fund And from and after the failure or determination of the trust of income hereinbefore contained in favour of my said son during his life and after the expiration of twenty one years after my death my Trustees shall hold the capital of the trust fund and the accumulations (if any) thereof but subject to the discretionary trust aforesaid UPON TRUST to pay and apply the income thereof or so much as shall not from time to time be applied under the same discretionary trust to the person or persons and in like manner as the same would be payable or applicable under the ulterior trusts concerning the same hereinafter contained if my said son were then actually dead without having made a Will And from and after the death of my said son my Trustees sh-

-all hold the trust fund and the accumulations (if any) thereof UPON TRUST to pay the income thereof unto the present or any future wife of my said son who may happen to survive him during the life of such wife or for such less period as my said son shall by Will appoint for her separate use without power/anticipation And after her death or sooner determination of her interest in the said income UPON TRUST to transfer the capital of the said trust fund unto such of the children or other issue of my said son and in such shares and manner in all respects as he shall by Will or Codicil appoint and subject to or in default of any such appointment then UPON TRUST to transfer the capital of the said trust fund unto or among such child or children of my said son whether born before or after the determination of his said life interest as being male attain the age of twenty one

years or being female attain or marry under that age and
if more than one in equal shares P R O V I D E D
that no child who or whose issue shall take any share
of the trust fund under any appointment to be made by
my said son shall in default of appointment to the
contrary take any part of the unappointed fund without
bringing the share appointed to him or her or to his
or her issue into hotchpot and accounting for the same
accordingly And in case my said son shall have no child
who shall acquire a vested interest in the trust fund
under the trusts aforesaid then subject and without
prejudice to the trusts powers and provisions hereinbefore
expressed or implied I D I R E C T that my Trustees
shall stand possessed thereof and of the income thereof or
of so much thereof respectively as shall not have become
vested or been applied under any of the said trust powers
or provisions after the death of my said son and the death

or sooner determination of the interest of any wife who may happen to survive him as aforesaid Upon TRUST for such person or persons as my said son shall by his Will or Codicil appoint.

9. MY TRUSTEES may raise and apply for the advancement of any child or other issue of mine one half or less of his or her presumptive or vested share but in the case of any child or other issue of my said son Frederick Arnold Goodliffe not during his lifetime without his consent in writing.

10. MY TRUSTEES may invest trust monies in or upon the public Stocks or Funds or Government Securities of the United Kingdom or of India or Canada or any British Colony or Dependency or in Bank Stock or in or upon any Foreign Stocks funds or securities guaranteed by the

British Government or the Debentures or Debenture Stock
Preference or Ordinary Stock or shares (fully paid up)
of any Railway Dock Gas or Water Company in the United
Kingdom or in India or Canada or any British Colony or
Dependency or at interest upon the Debentures Debenture
Stock or other securities of any Company or Corporate
Body authorised to borrow money or in or upon the pur-
chase or mortgage of any hereditaments in England or
Wales but not elsewhere being freehold or copyhold of
inheritance or leasehold for a term whereof not less than
fifty years shall be unexpired at the date of investment
or upon the security of any life estate or interest with
an Insurance on the life or lives on which such estate or
interest depends AND I DECLARE that my Trustees may at
their discretion change any investment for another or
others of the kind hereby authorised.

11. PENDING the preparation of or negotiation for any such investment or security as aforesaid and also while an investment is being sought for my Trustees may deposit in any Joint Stock or other Bank either at interest or otherwise any money liable to be invested under the trusts of this my Will.

12. MY TRUSTEES may manage and let on Lease or otherwise any devised or purchased real property including chattels real but all such property shall be deemed personal estate for the purposes of this my Will and when purchased shall be vested in my Trustees upon trust for sale at discretion with or without any disclosure of the trust And my Trustees may exercise over or in relation to any devised or purchased real property as aforesaid all such powers of or with reference to leasing as a tenant for life thereof might exercise under Sections 6 to 13 (both

inclusive) of the Settled Land Act 1882 and may make out of the income or capital of my real and personal estate any outlay which such Trustees may consider proper for improvements repairs Insurance calls on shares Premiums on Policies or otherwise for the benefit or in respect of my real and personal estate. _____

13. AND I also empower my Trustees to settle any question of law or fact apportion investments distinguish income from capital and generally act with reference to the trust premises as if they were absolute owners the decision of my Trustees in all cases of dispute and difference being hereby declared binding on all parties interested whether under disability or not. _____

14. THE expression "my Trustees" in this my Will shall include the Trustees hereby appointed and other the Trustees or Trustee for the time being. _____
